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# **Book Report/Book Talk**

Your project requires the following criteria:

### 1. Visual aspect

## 4. Rating (/5 stars)

You will give the book a rating out of 5 stars and explain your rating. What was good about the book? What could have been done better or differently? To whom would you recommend this book?
